“Seeds of Change”



Recently, the new President of Haiti commented that an essential key to Haiti’s long-term recovery is the establishment and re-establishment of its rural communities. Strong, sustainable, rural communities will allow Haiti to move closer to meeting the needs of its people, reduce its dependence on foreign and donated goods, and ease the burden of its major towns and cities.

For the past seven years, “Mountains of Hope for Haiti” (MHH) formerly the NYAC Task Force on Haiti, has been working in the mountainous village of Furcy to fulfill such a vision. Following the four hurricanes of 2008, “Mountains of Hope” started a Farmer’s Association, which provided much needed seed and fertilizer to farmers. This project not only met the emergency needs created by the hurricanes, but it also helped farmers establish a cooperative mission to their community which still operates today. Each year, MHH assists the farmers in their efforts. This year, MHH is seeking to provide \$9000 worth of seed, fertilizer, and tools to this agricultural community.
